Mobilizing a coalition focused on informing federal, state, local and institutional policies and regulations that support and serve the well-being, communicate the needs, and that enfranchise and empower the Black and African American community.



Increasing racial literacy, critical consciousness and cultural fluency in educational institutions and organizations.



Examining and interrogating systems, structures, actions, policies, procedures, and practices that impede the success of Black students and proposing new ideas, strategies, and approaches to advance the collective agenda of Black faculty, staff, and students.
